CV Guide: What to Include in Your CV

Job Profile

This is the formal version of how you would answer the interview question 'Tell me about yourself' **First sentence** – think of the adjectives that most describe you together with your normal line of work: e.g. A highly organised and efficient administrator with over ten years' experience... **Second and third sentences** – A summary of your work history, accomplishments and experience **Last sentence** – Availability statement e.g. Full clean driving licence, willing to work flexibly and available for immediate start.

Key Skills

Here you should include your primary skills / training relevant to job – e.g. Till-trained, fast and accurate, able to cash up etc. You can use the Work section of National Careers Service Job Profile as a source of ideas: <u>https://nationalcareers.service.gov.uk/explore-careers</u>

Employment

Include all of your relevant employment to date. This can include any voluntary work if paid employment is limited. Your employment should be in reverse chronological order (most recent role first) and should include your Job Title/s, Employer, Town, and Date to Date.

For each role include details of the job relative to the job you're applying for, again you could use the <u>Job Profiles link</u> to find direct or transferrable skills here. You should also include your achievements in that position.

Education and Training

You should include any training that is relevant to the role you're applying for. An example could be 'European Computer Driving Licence (ECDL)'. Then you should also include previous education, for example 'X GCSEs including English and Maths'.

It's worth noting that if your education is very relevant or impressive, you could include it above employment rather than underneath it.

Hobbies and Interests

Think about any hobbies that are especially relative to the job you're applying for, even if it's only loosely relevant through a transferrable skill such as team work etc.

References

At the end you can add 'References available on request'. Make sure you've got references available in case you're asked for them.

Conclusion & Templates

When it comes to quantity, one page is often ideal but two pages are okay. Just make sure you front-load the most important information. The first sift is often by a computer search for specific key words in the job description, and the second stage often takes 5 – 20 seconds per CV, focusing on what's visible on the first page.

The next two pages are example CVs using the advice given above. At the bottom of each example, you can find a link to the editable template.
