## **Mental Health Nurse**

#### **Adult Nurse**

Adult nurses care for adults who are sick, injured or have physical disabilities.

#### **Nursing Associate**

Nursing associates care for sick people of all ages in hospital and in the community, working closely with registered nurses.

### **Learning Disability Nurse**

Learning disability nurses take care of the social, psychological and physical health needs of people with a learning disability.

Children's nurses provide care for children and young people with health problems.
