## Mental Health Nurse

Mental health nurses work in hospitals and the community, to support people with mental health issues.

**Average salary:** £28,000 to £43,000

**Typical hours:** 37 to 38 a week - you could work evenings / weekends / bank holidays on shifts.

**You can get into this job through:**

a university course; an apprenticeship; a specialist course run by a professional body.



## Nursing Associate

Nursing associates care for sick people of all ages in hospital and in the community, working closely with registered nurses.

**Average salary:** £23,000 to £28,000

**Typical hours:** 38 to 40 a week - you could work evenings / weekends on shifts.

**You can get into this job through:**

a university course; an apprenticeship; working towards this role.



## District Nurse

District nurses care for people outside of hospital in patients' homes, GP surgeries and residential care homes.

**Average salary:** £35,000 to £43,000

**Typical hours:** 38 to 40 a week – you could work evenings/weekends/bank holidays on shifts.

**You can get into this job through:**

an apprenticeship or working towards this role.



## Learning Disability Nurse

Learning disability nurses take care of the social, psychological and physical health needs of people with a learning disability.

**Average salary:** £28,000 to £43,000

**Typical hours:** 36 to 38 a week – you could work evenings / weekends / bank holidays on shift.

**You can get into this job through:**

a university course or an apprenticeship.



## Adult Nurse

Adult nurses care for adults who are sick, injured or have physical disabilities.

**Average salary:** £28,000 to £43,000

**Typical hours:** 37 to 42 a week - you could work evenings / weekends / bank holidays on shifts.

**You can get into this job through:**

a university course or an apprenticeship.



## Children's Nurse

Children's nurses provide care for children and young people with health problems.

**Average salary:** £35,000 to £40,000

**Typical hours:** 37 to 42 a week - you could work evenings / weekends / bank holidays on shifts.

## Practice Nurse

Practice nurses work in GP surgeries to assess, screen, treat and educate patients, and help doctors give medical care.

**Average salary:** £28,000 to £50,000
