Radiographer

Dramatherapist

Dramatherapists use group work, role play and movement to help people with their feelings and emotions.

Physiotherapists assess and treat mobility problems in patients caused by illness, injury, ageing or disability.

Nutritionist

Nutritionists teach patients and clients about the effects of food on their health, motivating them to make positive changes to their diet.

Average salary: £28,000 to £43,000

Paramedic

Paramedics respond to emergency call-outs and give people life-saving medical help.

Average salary: £25,665 to £39,027

Art Therapist

Art therapists help people express difficult thoughts and feelings through creative activities.

Average salary: £35,000 to £50,000

Typical hours: 35 to 50 a week

Speech and language therapists help people with speaking and communication problems and those with eating and swallowing difficulties.

Average salary: £28,000 to £50,000

Typical hours: 38 to 40 a week
